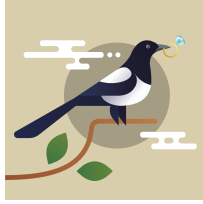

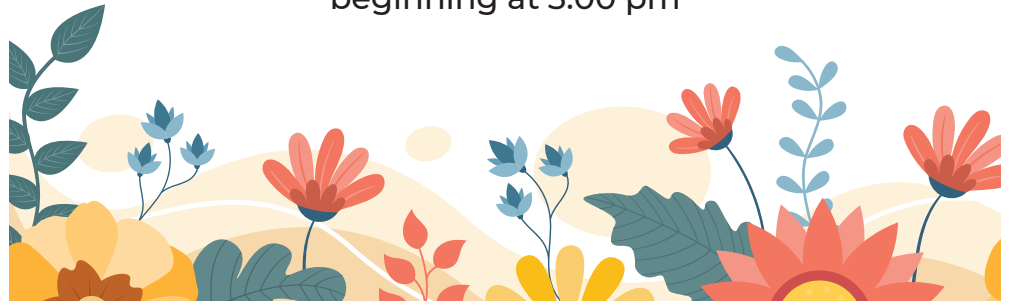
# RESIDENT SPOTLIGHT

Major League Baseball (MLB)

Opening Day begins Thursday, March 30th

and will be in full swing throughout the month of April.



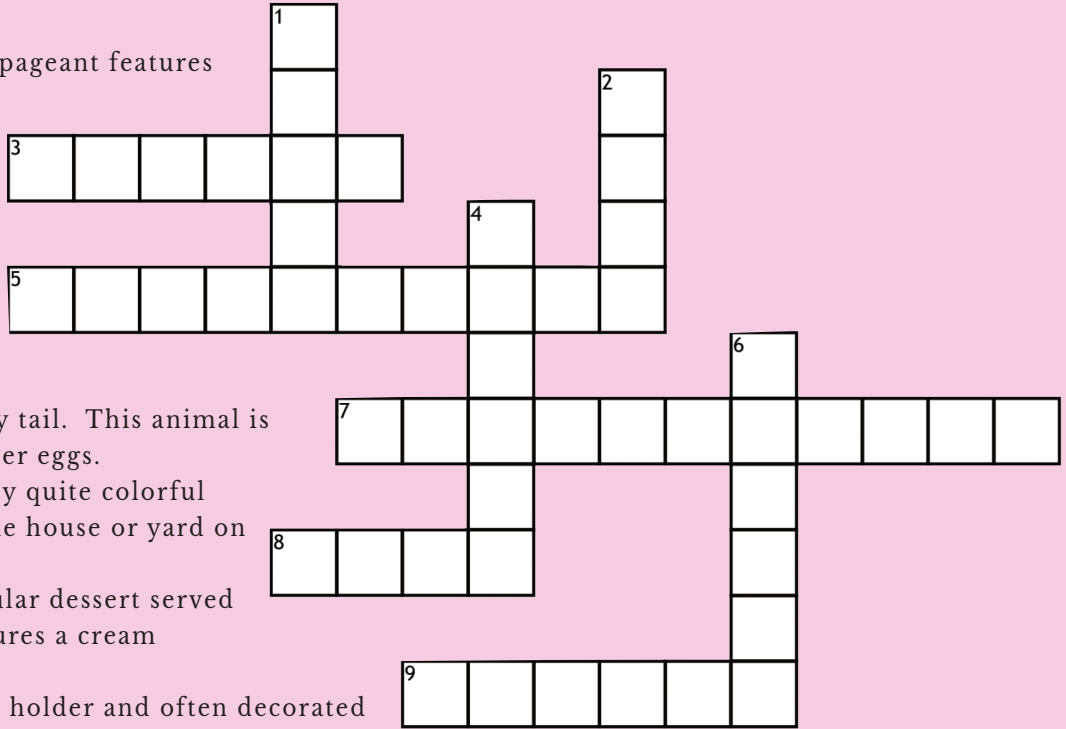
The seventh-inning stretch is as much a part of baseball tradition as hotdogs, beer, and booing umpires. There are various theories as to the reason for the 7th Inning Stretch, but our focus is on what you do during it. The custom is for fans to ritualistically stand and stretch before their team comes to bat in the seventh inning. Of course, this stretch helps to relieve stiff muscles due to sitting, but is also thought to bring luck to one's team. It has also become a tradition to sing the 1908 Tin Pan Alley song, "Take Me Out to the Ball Game". After 9/11, the San Diego Padres began playing "God Bless America" at the 7th Inning Stretch, and most MLB teams followed suit. Today, the New York Yankees are the only major league team to continue this newer tradition, with most teams reverting back to the original unofficial anthem of North American baseball, "Take Me Out to the Ball Game".
