



## Autumn Astronomy

## FALL EQUINOX


Wednesday, September 14 at 9:40 am

Most people know that the Earth spins on a tilted axis as the planet orbits around the Sun. But twice a year, there is no "tilt" and the Earth is not inclined toward or away from the sun. Each of those times arrives with the Fall (autumnal) and Spring (vernal) equinox, the name of which is derived from the Latin words for equal (*aequus*) and night (*nox*). After the Fall equinox, the northern side of the Earth begins to tilt away from the sun, and after the Spring equinox, the earth begins to tilt back towards the sun.
