
EXTRAORDINARY PEOPLE, EXTRAORDINARY NEWS

Cognition refers to all of the mental processes involved in act of learning, comprehension, remembering, and the using of knowledge to problem solve. The study of how we think (cognition) dates all the way back to the time of the ancient Greek philosophers Plato and Aristotle. The earliest definition of “cognition” was presented in the first textbook on cognitive psychology, authored by psychologist Ulric Neisser and published in 1967. According to Neisser, cognition is “those processes by which the sensory input is transformed, reduced, elaborated, stored, recovered and used.”


