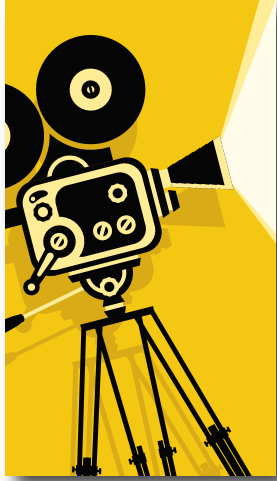

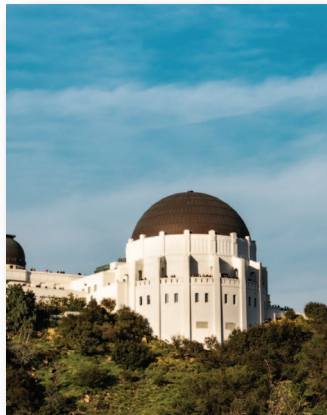

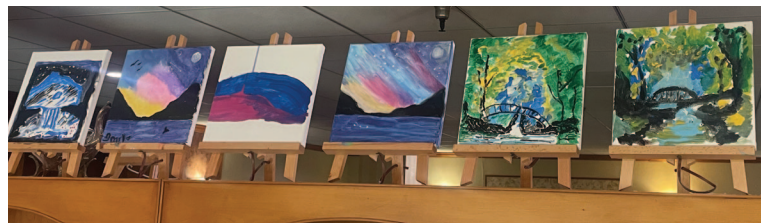


OUTING TO GRIFFITH OBSERVATORY

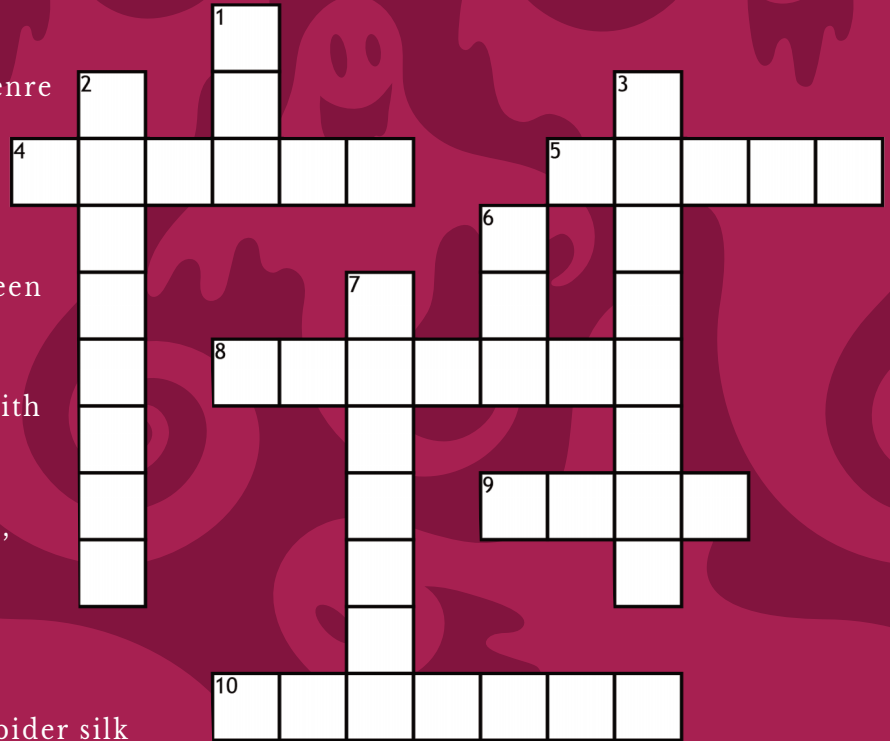


HALLOWEEN CROSSWORD
